

## **INSTALLATION STEPS**

- 1. Clear the vehicle's trunk where holes will be drilled through the trunk floor.
- 2. Hold the CM-11579-MBWA in place against the vehicle's tie down bracket under the rear of the car. On the passenger side, it should fit on the inside of the tie down bracket, and on the outside of the frame rail on the driver side. Using fasteners as shown, mount the CM-11579-MBWA to the vehicle's tie down bracket making sure CM-SP102 plate seats into bracket to prevent movement.
- 3. Adjust the CM-11579-MBWA to be square and straight across the vehicle. On the driver's side of the vehicle, use the hitch as a template to drill (2) holes in the trunk floor for 3/8" fasteners. Mount the CM-11579-MBWA at these points with fasteners as shown using the CM-11579-BP plate inside the car.
- 4. Bolt the CM-11579-BMWA to the CM-11579-MBWA as shown.
- 5. After checking to make sure the tongue is square with the vehicle, use the tail bracket as a template to drill the trunk floor for (2) 3/8" fasteners. Mount the CM-11579-BMWA to the floor at the tail bracket as shown, making sure to use fender washers inside the vehicle opposite the hitch.
- 6. Torque all 3/8" fasteners to 30 lb-ft.
- 7. Use silicone sealant to seal hardware installed through trunk floor.
- 8. Reinstall contents removed in Step 1.
