

## **INSTALLATION STEPS**

- 1) Install fasteners as shown. Some models may require mounting hole to be reamed out to 1/2".
- 2) Installations on boxed-in frames will be made easier by fishwiring the bolts and spacers into the holes from an existing access hole. Wrap a wire around the threads of the bolt at the end and pull wire, bolt, and spacers back through the access hole through the attachment hole.
- 3) Raise the hitch into position, taking care not to push bolts back into frame. The large slot on each side fits over the rivet. Secure each bolt with a flange nut.
- 4) Torque all hardware to 75 lb.-ft.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
