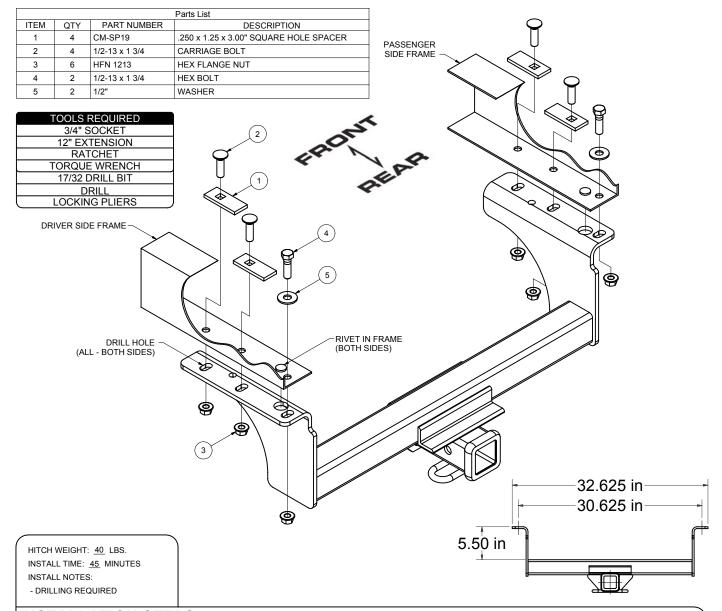

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Raise the hitch into position centering the tabs in the frame to the 1" holes on the sideplates and clamp to the frame using locking pliers.
- 2. Mark the six slot centers of both sideplates on the frame rails and drill with a 17/32" bit.
- 3. Attach the hardware as shown in the figure above.
- 4. Torque all 1/2" hardware to 75 ft.-lbs.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
