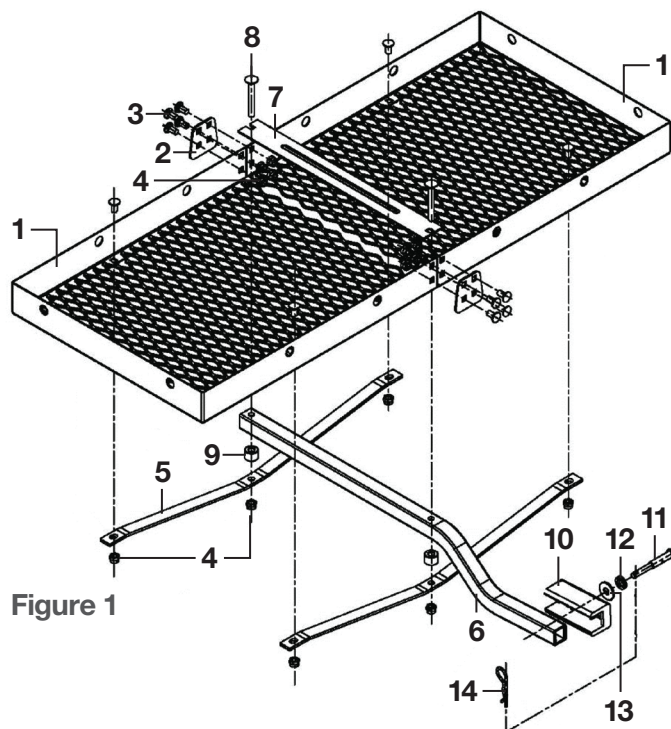

## SUGGESTED TOOLS

Open wrench, 17mm and 19mm



## WARNINGS

Do not exceed maximum weight capacity of 500 lbs. when using 2" receiver tube. Distribute the weight evenly on platform when hauling a load. **NOTE:** This carrier is not intended for transporting people.

Do not carry loads wider or deeper than carrier. Do not carry flammable items on carrier. Do not allow exhaust fumes to blow directly on items. This is a fire hazard.

# ASSEMBLY

## Step 1

Align the two platform halves (#1), as shown below. Using the top two holes only, connect the platform halves (#1) and connecting plates (#2) with M10\*20 carriage bolts (#3) and M10 locknuts (#4). Tighten to 80% only.

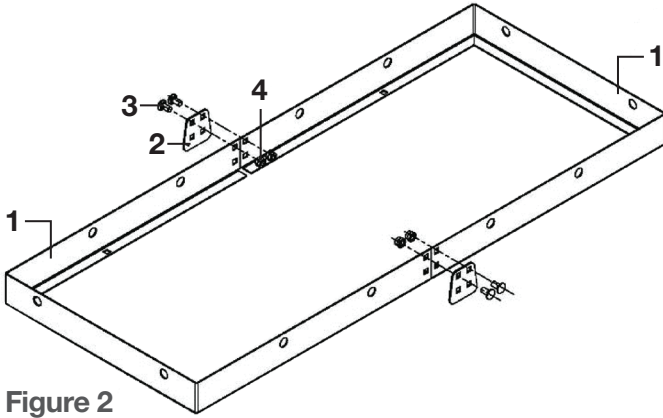

## Step 2

Put the 1 1/4" shank (#6) under the middle of platform (#1). Place the round tube pads (#9) and the support bridges (#5) under the 1 1/4" shank (#6). Place the flat brace (#7) in the top middle of the platform (#1). Connect by tightening the M10\*75 carriage bolt (#8) and M10 locknut (#4) to 80% tightness.

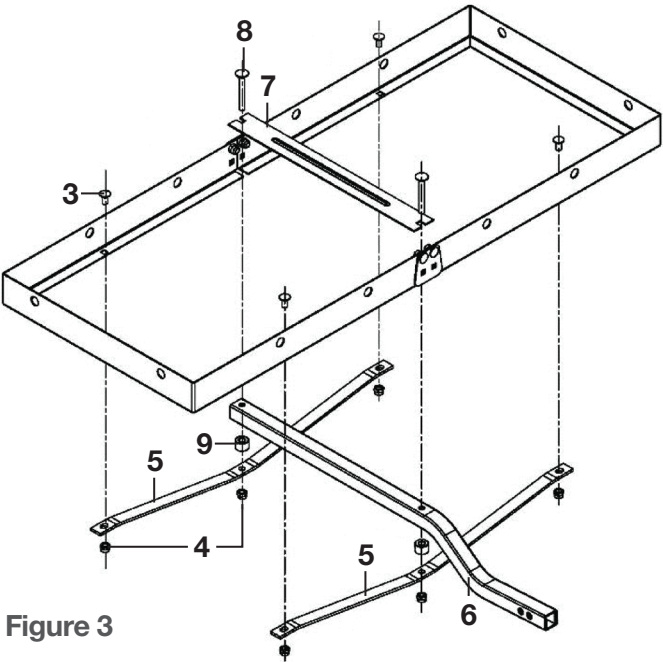

## Step 3

Using the bottom two holes, finish connecting the platform halves (#1) and connecting plates (#2) with M10\*20 carriage bolts (#3) and M10 locknuts (#4). Tighten to 80% only.

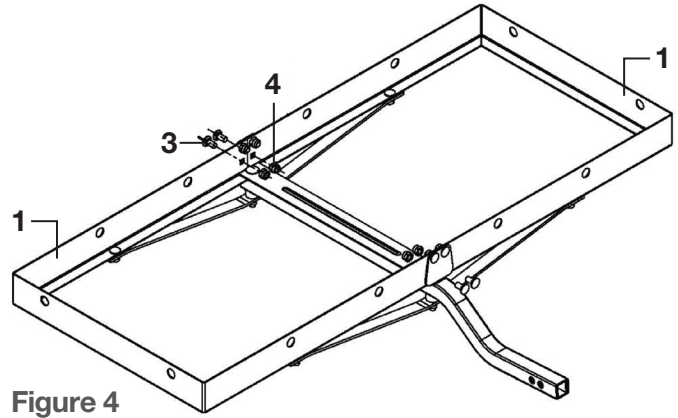

## Step 4

Fully tighten all of the bolts and locknuts.

## Step 5

To adapt the 1 1/4" shank to a 2" shank, assemble the U-type adapter (#10) onto the 1 1/4" shank (#6). Align the holes and secure with the 1/2" flat washer (#13), 1/2" spring washer (#12), 1/2" hex head bolt (#11) and clip (#14).

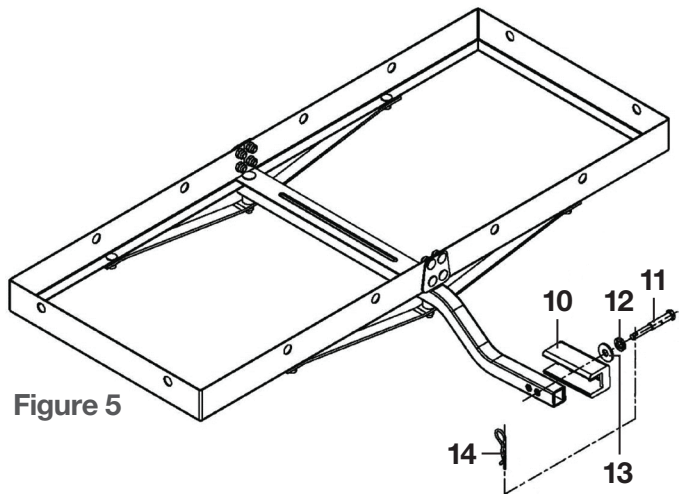
