

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED:

WIRING ACCESS LOCATION: PC3, PC4

DRILL BITS:

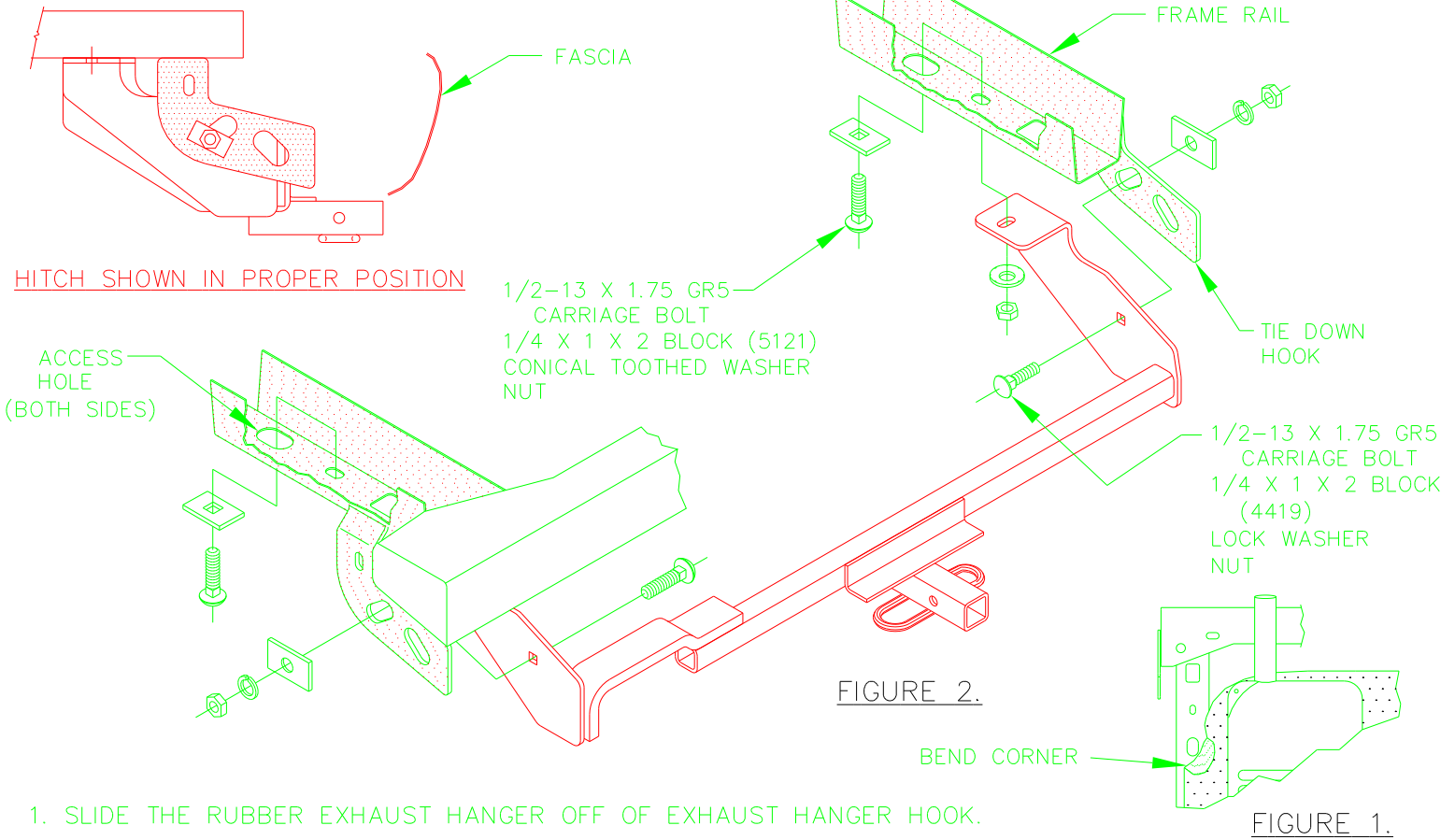
HITCH REQUIRES 1/2" PIN & CLIP

WRENCHES: (TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS WITH TORQUE WRENCH) 7/8

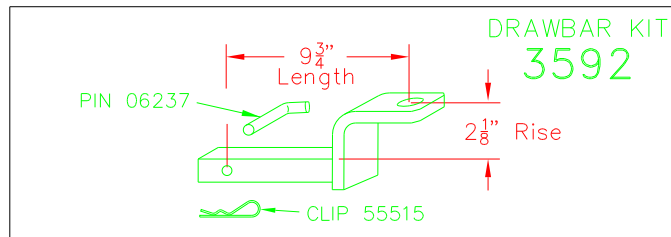
2000 LB MAX GROSS TRAILER WT
200 LB MAX TONGUE WEIGHT
DO NOT EXCEED TOWING VEHICLE RATINGS

NOTE: FASTENERS TYPICAL BOTH SIDES



1. SLIDE THE RUBBER EXHAUST HANGER OFF OF EXHAUST HANGER HOOK.
2. BEND CORNER OF MUFFER HEAT SHIELD DOWN TO INCREASE CLEARANCE TO ACCESS HOLE ON DRIVER'S SIDE FRAME – SEE FIGURE 1.
3. RAISE HITCH INTO POSITION AND LOOSELY INSTALL THE REARWARD FASTENERS.
4. FISHWIRE CARRIAGE BOLT AND BLOCK THRU ACCESS HOLE IN FRAME RAIL, BOTH SIDES, AS SHOWN.
5. INSTALL REMAINING FASTENERS AS SHOWN – SEE FIGURE 2.
6. REATTACH RUBBER EXHAUST HANGER.

TIGHTEN ALL 1/2 GR5 FASTENERS TO 75 LB-FT.



USE ONLY THE DRAWBAR SHOWN FOR CORRECT BUMPER CLEARANCE AND HEIGHT.
DRAWBAR MUST BE USED IN THE RISE POSITION ONLY.

NOTE: Check hitch frequently, making sure all fasteners and ball are properly tightened. If hitch is removed, plug all holes in trunk pan or other body panels to prevent entry of water and exhaust fumes. A hitch or ball which has been damaged should be removed and replaced. Observe safety precautions when working beneath a vehicle and wear eye protection. Follow car maker's specs for maximum trailer weight and tongue weight. Do not cut access or attachment holes with a torch.
