Warnings

<u>Truck Bed and Camper Protection</u>

Torklift <u>does not</u> recommend installing your camper on top of a plastic bed liner (or other compressible material such as foam). These materials can act as a spring, causing increased vertical truck camper movement independent of the vehicle. Plastic bed liners can slide on the truck bed surface, and the truck camper can slide on top of the bed liner. Using a plastic bed liner or similar compressible material will <u>void your warranty</u> and may additionally cause truck bed and/or camper damage.

Minor movement or settling can occur in some incidental harsh driving conditions (on or off-road). A rubber bed mat is recommended to protect the truck bed and camper, but is not a requirement to maintain the Torklift legendary lifetime warranty.

Suspension

To significantly reduce body roll, sag and sway Torklift strongly recommends the StableLoad. Torklift International StableLoads improve safety, handling, and to help level your truck. More information can be found at (www.Torklift.com/stableload).

If your truck is additionally equipped with suspension air bags Torklift cautions against over pressurization as this may lead to unsafe vehicle handling characteristics. We have found that airbags used in conjunction with StableLoads have allowed operators to lower air bag pressure by 50% or more. Only pressurize suspension air bags enough to level the truck.



Step 1:

Begin on the passenger side of the vehicle and remove the forward most bed mount bolt as shown below in photo 1.1 below.

Note: The bolt is secured with blue thread locking compound and is tightened to a very high torque value.




Step 2:

Lift the passenger side **tie down receiver** up into place so that the hole in the bent strap aligns with the hole in the vehicle bed mount. Secure the tie down in place by re-installing the bolt removed in step one and leaving finger tight at this time. Reference figure 2.1 on the following page.

Step 3:

Install one of the Clamp Straps on the inside of the frame rail from the bottom of the frame up. Install one 1/2"-13 x 4" Hex Bolt with one 1/2" SAE Washer through the front of the tie down receiver and out through upper hole in the Clamp Strap. Secure with one 1/2" Lock Washer and one 1/2" Hex Nut. Reference figure 3.1 and leave hardware hand tight at this time. Repeat the process for the other Clamp Strap.



Step 4:

Install one 1/2"-13 x 4" Hex Bolt with one 1/2" SAE Washer through each of the remaining two holes on the bottom of the tie down receiver. Install a spacer pipe onto each bolt between the tie down receiver and clamp straps. Secure with one 1/2" Lock Washer and one 1/2" Hex Nut. Reference figure 3.1 and leave hardware hand tight at this time.

Step 5:


Begin to tighten each of the four hex bolts in turn, until both the front and rear clamp straps are seated flush to the inside of the vehicle frame. Next, re-tighten the bed mount bolt and torque to **80 ft-lbs**. Torque the two upper hex bolts <u>without</u> the tubing spacers to **15 ft-lbs**. Next, torque the lower two hex bolts <u>with</u> the tubing spacers to **55 ft-lbs**.

The Passenger side tie down installation is complete.

Step 6:

Directly behind the rear most cab mount on the driver side of the frame, there are two M10 hex bolts holding the cross member to the frame. Remove them. The cross member will not move.

Remove the farthest forward bed mounting bolt on the driver side of the frame. See figure 6.1




Step 7:

Loosely attach the driver side receiver to the bed mount using the original hardware. Keep the bolt loose so the receiver is free to move.

With the receiver loosely attached to the bed mount, slide two M10-1.25 x 50mm Grade 10.9 Hex Bolts with one 7/16" Lock Washer and one 7/16" USS Flat washer each through the two forward holes on the driver side receiver and all three Frame Spacers.


Loosely secure the bolts through the vehicles cross member and into the frame. See figure 7.1



Step 8:

Install the last Clamp Strap on the inside of the frame rail from the bottom of the frame up. Install one 1/2"-13 x 4" Hex Bolt with one 1/2" SAE Washer through the front of the tie down receiver and out through upper hole in the Clamp Strap. Secure with one 1/2" Lock Washer and one 1/2" Hex Nut. Reference figure 8.1 and leave hardware hand tight at this time.

Install one 1/2"-13 x 4" Hex Bolt with one 1/2" SAE Washer through remaining hole on the bottom of the tie down receiver. Install a spacer pipe onto the bolt between the tie down receiver and clamp strap. Secure with one 1/2" Lock Washer and one 1/2" Hex Nut. Reference figure 8.1 and leave hardware hand tight at this time.



Step 9:

Torque the bed mount bolt to 80 ft-lbs.

Torque the M10-1.25 x 50mm Grade 10.9 Hex Bolts to 45 ft-lbs

Torque the upper 1/2"-13 x 4" Grade 8 Hex Bolt <u>WITHOUT</u> the spacer pipe to 15 ft-lbs

Torque the lower 1/2"-13 x 4" Grade 8 Hex Bolt **WITH** the spacer pipe to 55 ft-lbs

TIEDOWN INSERT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

On one end of each of your tie down inserts is a triangular plate referred to by Torklift as a bullet plate. In most cases, the tie down inserts should be installed with the shorter side of the bullet plate facing away from each other, i.e.. The shorter side of the front insert should point to the front of the truck and the shorter side of the rear insert should point towards the rear of the truck.

Once installed, attach the TorkLift directional stickers to the face of the bullet plate on the insert as a reminder. Once in place, the tie down inserts must be pinned in place with the provided 2-1/4" Insert Pins. Either hole can be used as long as there is sufficient clearance between the turn buckle and truck body.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Your tie down inserts are designed to have clearance inside of the receiver. This is to account for road debris, as well as aid in installation and removal. Some rattle may be expected if the inserts are left installed while not under load from the camper.
