Electric or Chargeable ½" or 3/8" Drill



1/4 " Drill Bit



10mm Open End Wrench & Socket Wrench




b) (1)Flap Assembly Front, PS Part #759805



INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)


- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Cut the protective plastic and peel away from the stainless steel. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove four (4) factory screws #5 to #8 from the wheel well as shown in the diagram and reinstall the four (4) factory screws through slots #1 to #4. Loosely tightened at this point.
- 3. Square the flap with the tire, while putting pressure against the wheel well, then tighten the four (4) reinstalled factory screws.
- 4. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.
