






INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your mud flap and bracket set, see the diagrams and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove 3 factory push pins from the fender on factory holes #6 to #8
- 3. Loosely install clip (n) on mud flap hole #2 using a screw (c) and flat washer (h)
- 4. Install mud flap hole #4 to factory hole #7 using a machine screw (a) and flat washer (g) and secure with a flat washer (d), lock washer (j) and hex nut (l).
- 5. Slide clip (n) on mud flap hole #2 between flare and liner.
- 6. Install clip (n) between flare and liner, aligned with mud flap hole #1, and secure mud flap to clip using a screw (c) and flat washer (h)
- 7. Install mud flap hole #3 to factory hole #6 using a screw (a) and flat washer (g), and secure with a flat washer (d), lock washer (j), and hex nut (l)
- 8. Install mud flap hole #5 through spacer (m) into factory hole #8 using a bolt (b) and flat washer (f) and secure using a flat washer (e), lock washer (i), and hex nut (k).
- 9. Using a bubble or another leveling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level and tighten all fasteners.
- 10. Repeat procedure on passenger's side.








INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your mud flap and bracket set, see the diagrams and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove the lower fender liner by removing the 3 factory screws from the fender. Set aside for reinstallation later.
- 3. Loosen bumper bolts, slide bracket behind bolts, and install bracket to the factory hole using a bolt (b) and flat washer (f) and secure using a flat washer (f), lock washer (i), and hex nut (k). Tighten bumper bolts. (See Diagram #1).
- 4. Remove factory push pin from fender.
- 5. Install clips (m) on mud flap holes #2 & #3 using a screw (d) and flat washer (h). (See Diagram #2).
- 6. Install mud flap hole #1 to factory hole where push pin was removed using a machine screw (a) and flat washer (h), and secure using a flat washer (e), lock washer (j), and hex nut (l). (See Diagram #2).
- 7. Slide clips (m) behind fender.
- 8. Install mud flap holes #4 & #5 to bracket holes #6 & #7 using a bolt (c), and flat washer (g) and secure using a flat washer (f), lock washer (i), and hex nut (k). (See Diagram #2).
- 9. Using a bubble or another leveling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level and tighten all fasteners.
- 10. Reinstall the factory cover using the factory hardware removed in step 2.
